TO OBTAIN A MARRIAGE LICENCE IN THE TOWN OF RHINEBECK

The Rhinebeck Town Clerk's office is open to issue marriage licenses Tuesdays through Thursdays from 9:30 am to 2:30 pm. No appointment is necessary. Both members of the couple must be present at Town Hall, 80 East Market Street. The cost is \$40 (we take cash or checks only).

Any person who has been married must provide proof of the dissolution of *all* prior marriages (usually by a divorce decree or a death certificate).

A person is also required to establish proof of identity with one of the following documents:

- 1. Driver's license
- 2. Passport
- 3. Another Government issued photo ID (for example, prison ID)

AND

1. Certified Birth Certificate (certified translation if not in English)

All documents not in English must be submitted with a certified translation.

The marriage license is good for 60 days after issuance, but there is a 24-hour waiting period from issuance before it can be used.
